DO I NEED PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE?

There are no essential prerequisites but if you hold a Certificate III in Individual Support or industry experience, or a Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing or HAC) you may be able to apply for recognition of Prior Learning or Credit Transfers.

CAN I FAST-TRACK THE COURSE?

Yes, we will acknowledge your previous skills and experience and shorten the course if you:

Have been working in the industry for more than two years.

Have previous qualifications issued by other educational institutions that have been completed in full and match the course units.

We can also shorten the course by recognising your work placement if you currently work in the industry, for example, a respite centre, aged care facility or disability service and can provide a letter from your employer.

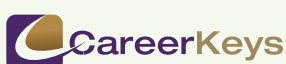
